1. Record Status - As this is a Record Status Tournament GNAS dress regulations (Rule 307) apply. Record Status Tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply.

Refusal will be treated as a positive result. It is a requirement of Record Status Events that parents/guardians of juniors must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.

- **2. GNAS** All archers must be affiliated to GNAS and will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
- **3. Scoring -** Double scoring (with two score cards) will be employed. Five-zone scoring will be used for this shoot and so the 'odds & evens' rules applies. Impossible scores will not be accepted.
- **4. Handicaps -** Please declare a handicap on your entry form. There are several handicap awards for un-rewarded on the day EMAS archers.
- **5. Arrows** Please note that all arrows must be accounted for as such archers wishing to use arrows that are not metal detector responsive i.e. all carbon, are requested to identify their equipment with the judges before the commencement of the shoot and again on departure.
- **6. Photography -** In compliance with GNAS Child Protection guidelines any person wishing to engage in any form of photography or video must register with the Tournament Organiser.
- **7.** Refreshments will be available.
- 8. Wheelchair archers please state whether right or left handed.
- **9. Cancellations** No refunds will be given for cancellations after the closing date.
- **10. Disclaimer -** Please note: EMAS and Kirby Muxloe Archery Club do not accept any liability for personal injury, loss or damage to competitor's equipment or possessions however so caused.
