#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. All archers must be affiliated to Archery GB or a WA Member Association; they will be asked to produce their membership cards when signing in.
- 2. Awards will be made to all classes, subject to entry.
- 3. Archers should arrive in time for kit inspection which will commence 20 minutes before assembly.
- 4. Sessions B & C will not start before their specified times
- 5. Two practice ends will be shot at the start of each WA 18 round.
- 6. WA vertical triple faces will be used for compound archers. Other archers will use a single spot face, although they may request a vertical triple face.
- 7. Archery GB dress regulations as shown in Archery GB Rule 307 will apply. In addition, soft soled shoes must be worn.
- 8. Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply; refusal will be treated as a positive result. Juniors' entry forms must be signed by a parent or guardian to signify their consent to their child being tested if approached.
- 9. Light refreshments will be available.
- 10. Smoking and vaping are not permitted on the College site, including the car parks.
- 11. Anyone wishing to take photographs during the tournament must register their details with the tournament organisers on arrival. Please notify the organisers if you have concerns about your child/young person being photographed or you notice any unauthorised photography.
- 12. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.
- 13. Target and results lists will be sent in .pdf format to those providing an e-mail address. If necessary, hard copies will be sent to those providing a stamped, self-addressed envelope (23cm x 16cm minimum) with their entry.
- 14. No refunds can be made after the closing date.
