1. Archery GB (AGB) Dress Regulations as shown in rule 307 will apply.
2. All archers must be affiliated to AGB and will be asked to produce their AGB membership cards when signing in.
3. Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents/Guardians of competitors under the Age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to drug testing, if required.
4. Target list and results will be emailed out to those including an email address and posted on the L&RCAA website - www.lrcaa.co.uk.
5. Changes of handicap must be notified to the organiser before sighters to be eligible for awards.
6. The results will be posted for 5 minutes for objections before the presentation, after which no alterations will be made.
7. AGB Policy for Safeguarding Children, Young People and Vulnerable Adults requires that any persons wishing to engage in any type of photography or videoing must register with the organisers on arrival before carrying out such activity.
