2. Minutes from the last meeting – approved

3. <u>Matters Arising</u>. Mark advised that EMAS approved the proposal that the new club boss grant be increased to £250, and be paid to Apollo.

4. Treasurer's report.

6. Affiliations

7. Development and Coaching.

COACHING

We currently have 34 coaches, and 4 in training, and 9 lapsed.

Any coach renewals received will need an up to date Safeguarding Certificate.

There is an alternate renewal course if you have done a course within the last 3 years.

With this years matched \pm 300 funding from EMAS, we have ±600 which can be used for coach renewals.

Maggie proposed that we :

Either pay £12.50 or £10 to each coach when they renew. Then the coach could ask their club for a donation. **Or** for face to face delivery organised local for 6-20 people with 2 options : £385 which includes delivery, digital resource and certificate for every learner Or £450 for above with hard copy resources to organiser, plus room hire.

The meeting agreed to do face to face with hard copy.

The course can also be opened to club safeguarding officers and any county committee members who need them.

During the last EMAS meeting it was agreed there is another £300 matched funding available for the counties to do alternative cpd courses such as first aid, lanseo training etc.

Maggie received correspondence from a school in Rutland looking for an archery coaches As the 2 local clubs couldn't help them, and has arranged a self-employed coach to provide the service. As CCO and Development, Maggie suggested putting together a list of people who could provide this within Leicestershire,

ACTION if any clubs have members that can do this please let Maggie know.

The Junior shoot took place on Sunday 13th March, 9 juniors from 4 different clubs took part. Thank you to Foxes, and the coaches. Both the parents and juniors enjoyed the day. The consensus is that they would like monthly meets, and slightly shorter times.

8. EMAS Rep.

The Teams make up for the Thoresby and Sydney Bond are under review.

Any senior will be able to submit their 12 dozen rounds for consideration to the EMAS team captain (this will be added to the EMAS website).

They have approved new shirt design (Lionheart).
