7. **Development and Coaching.**

Maggie gave an update:

We had 4 juniors show an initial interest in the Sidney Bond tournament, but near the time they already had other things arranged for the day. eg it clashed with the junior uk masters.

The safeguarding course organised through uk coaching went well.

An email was sent out to all Current coaches regarding the course and GDPR (17 out of 43 replied, no-one advised that they don't want emails sent, so we shall continue to send them.

Maggie has had several ideas put forward for future cpd coaching juniors. E.g. changing your language, keeping their focus, setting age appropriate goals, keeping safeguarding in mind, handling parents etc.

Bow setups. Recurve Barebow compound etc

Disability & equipment, Mental, First aid, nutrition.

How to prepare for tournaments.

We agreed the format for development days – Juniors am, Seniors pm. Cost £5 Junior, £10 Seniors.

To avoid any conflict of interest we will employ Maggie to organise the first session, with help from County Coaches. Note: Maggie will continue to volunteer some of my time.

Maggie will send out info to clubs and for publising on social media.

It is time consuming to do 4 Jobs for the county - To forward plan Junior /senior development days outdoor, concensus is to avoid Sundays as they are tournament days. it requires dates to be organised, Clubs volunteered venues. We need a junior rep who doesn't work weekends.

Maggie has created a Questionaire to be sent to club Chairs.

AGB info:

Helen reminded us that AGB are offering a support fund for clubs to apply for eg help to clubs to cater for the boost in beginner numbers (and will give County the opportunity to match funding, which means the admin will be done for us by AGB).

Neill, Eddie and Maggie have had an initial meeting with the South Leicestershire School Sport Partnership to discuss a joint initiative with L&R schools, to develop a programme that will be self sustained in local schools and will provide a feed of juniors (and their families) into local clubs. It is early days yet, and a second meeting is scheduled for 10th August. We also have the benefit of input from Integr8archery who has been running a programme in Northants.

8. EMAS Rep.

A new Senior Team manager is required.

They wanted to know why there were so few archers at the Thoresby (Post Covid there are significantly less people attending any competitions).

Asked if L&R could host 2023 Clout – Rutland are unable to host so we have declined.

9. Records Officer.

Currently for the 2021-22 season there have been:

4 claims for Classification badges, all from senior archers. 3rd Class - 1, 2nd Class - 1, 1st Class - 1, Bowman - 1

Notts Match and County Champs will be held at Bowmen of Glen – LRCAA have taken over organising the event after BoG had to cancel their competitions that weekend.
